Welcome to Year 5

We hope that you all had a wonderful summer and are looking forward to the exciting year ahead of us. We are really excited to be back and to meet the children again.

PE will take place every Monday afternoon for 5C and on Friday afternoons for 5P and 5H. Please can you ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on their allocated PE day and that it is washed each week. Homework will be set every Wednesday and should be completed and returned by the following Monday. We do explain the activities when we set them and the work reflects current learning. If your child finds any of the activities set difficult to complete, let us know and we can go through them again.


