## **Procedures at Hardwicke** If a child displays:



a high temperature (37.8\*C) - they will feel hot on their head and back

a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Then we will contact parent/carer. Please come and collect your child as soon as you can. You will be asked to take any siblings with you.

## **Next Steps**

- Whole household should isolate
- Book a test for the child with symptoms
- If Positive-the child needs to isolate for 10 days and the household for 14 days
- If negative-please return all children to school assuming they are fit and well.
