

## English

- The children will do Guided Reading with an adult once a week, with other reading tasks throughout the week as well.
- In English we will read **Farmer Duck**, **Avocado Baby** and **Eat up Gemma!** We will base our creative writing around these stories.
- After half term we will be writing reports on animal types, instructions on how to make a healthy meal and creating shape poetry.
- We will practise writing our common exception words and put them into sentences and also keep up handwriting practice.



## Maths

Our learning objectives in Maths for this term will focus on place value and number knowledge, including:

- Number bonds to 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16.
- Addition and subtraction facts of these numbers.
- Measuring length.

After half term...

- Number bonds to 17, 18, 19 and 20.
- Addition and subtraction facts of these numbers.
- Fractions
- Position and Direction.



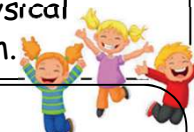
## Religious Education
